- What resources can they share with you, so that you, too, can be successful?
- Action Item: Copy the structure and add your own style.

3. Plan for the FUTURE

- Who will be doing this role in the future?
- What resources can you provide, so they can have similar success?
- What structure can you give to them to copy and add their own style?
